Achievements

- Nation's third largest, non-profit, secular healthcare system (*Modern Healthcare*)
- Nation's 14th largest integrated healthcare network (*Modern Healthcare*), and largest in the Northeast
- Service area of 5.2 million people in Long Island, Queens and Staten Island
- Recipient of the Codman Award from the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations (JCAHO), the first health system to attain this distinction.
- Operates only hospitals in New York State to be honored with *Magnet Recognition for Excellence in Nursing Service* — the highest honor in the nursing profession.

- Core Laboratory in Lake Success — Around-the-clock testing facility offering advanced testing services to hospitals, private physicians and the bio-medical industry.
- Center for Emergency Medical Services in Syosset — The largest emergency services operation in the East, with 50 EMS vehicles and 270+ EMTs.
- Two long-term care facilities
 - Center for Extended Care and Rehabilitation in Manhasset
 - Geriatric Division of Franklin Hospital Medical Center
- Seven home health agencies — Provide more than 685,000 home care visits annually.
