Dear Dr. Adkins,

Thank you for referring your patient **Catherine Test**, DOB 03.03.1953, 187 Gudge Health Lane, Fareham, Hampshire, PO15 6QA.

Indication: Suspected ovarian cyst seen on ultrasound.

History:

Age: 55 years.

Past gynaecological disorders: Cervical dysplasia in 2002.

Past gynaecological operations: Conisation. Laser treatment of genital condyloma.

Gynaecological Ultrasonography:

Method: GE Voluson E8, transvaginal ultrasound, 2 D, 3 D. View: Suboptimal - restricted because of increased bowel gas or activity.

Uterus: Anteverted, longitudinal 80 mm, ap 52 mm, transverse 75 mm. Volume: 163,4 ml.

Endometrium: Endometrium clearly visualised. Thickness (total): 9,0 mm.

Right ovary: Visibility: Clearly seen. Outline smooth. Size: 33 mm x 42 mm x 30 mm. Volume: 21,8 ml.

Right ovary contains a simple cyst: Size: 23 mm x 34 mm x 22 mm. Volume: 9,0 ml.

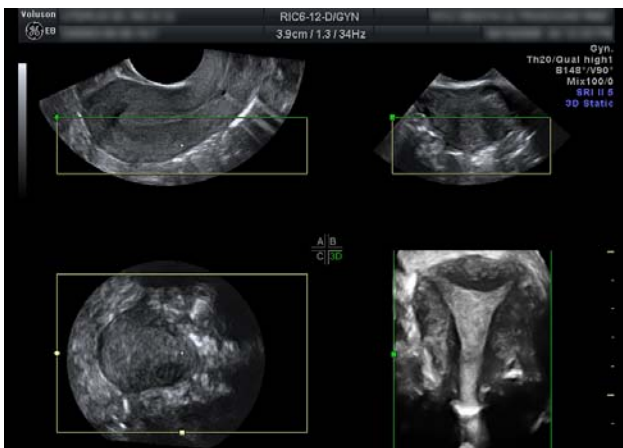
Left ovary: Visibility: Clearly seen. Normal morphology. Size: 22 mm x 24 mm x 22 mm. Volume: 6,1 ml.

Diagnosis:

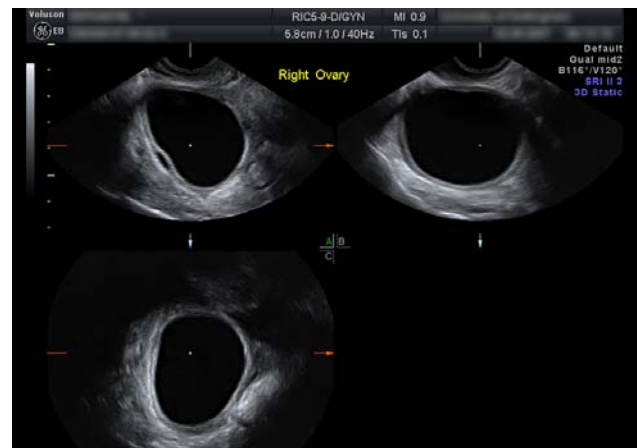
Right ovary shows a simple cyst measuring 22 x 23 x 24 mm. Left ovary appears normal within physiological limits.

Therapy / Recommendations:

We recommend a sonographic control in 3 months.
