Course Summary:

Participants will learn how to configure and maintain iCentrals and their Datex-Ohmeda and Unity peripherals. These include: printers, recorders, iCentral Clients, Datex-Ohmeda and GE Healthcare bedside monitors. Participants will learn about the system's capabilities, components and will learn troubleshooting skills to help keep the system up and running. Participants will also connect and configure Mobile Viewer version 2 and construct a small hospital enterprise to connect hospital PC and Palm PCs to the Mobile Viewer 2 system.
