The iCenter website gives you access to the GE Medical Systems Service Database with DI Asset Management – comprehensive information for GE-provided services for all of your contracted, in-warranty and hourly-billed imaging devices. From aggregated reports to the detailed Electronic Service Records...



- **Equipment Status Dashboard** – Color-coded display shows you at a glance any open requests for service in a specific modality.
- **Open Dispatch Display** – Aggregate and high-level details displayed for all open dispatches in the GEMS system for contracted, in-warranty and hourly-billed-service devices. Drill down to see the date the dispatch was created, the initiating person and the symptom requiring service.

- **30/60/90-Day Summaries of Pending PMs** – Readily references which devices have PMs scheduled in the next 30, 60 or 90 days, as well as the date of the last PM on each device.
- **24-Month PM Summary View** – Retrospective look at all of the PMs performed on your devices in the past year and prospective look at the PMs scheduled for the coming year.
