



Powered Mobile Equipment (PME)

GE HealthCare Life Saving Principles

Segregate pedestrians and operate powered mobile equipment as trained

Always

- 1 Operate only if you are trained, competent, authorized and familiar with the operating instructions
- 2 Perform a visual inspection before use, report and remove from use, if damaged
- 3 Check load capacity, stability, center of gravity, and make sure forks are lowered when the vehicle is traveling or parked
- 4 Wear your seat belt at all times and high-visibility garments when required
- 5 Establish restricted areas separating pedestrians and PMEs
- 6 Secure trailer from movement before entering with a PME

Never

- 1 Transport unsecured loads or underestimate ground slope or floor openings
- 2 Use fork attachments without understanding limitations and verifying capacity
