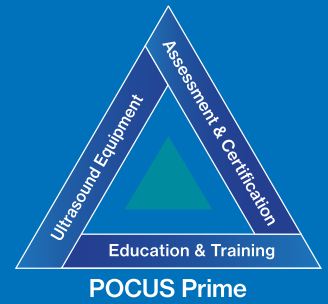

POCUS Foundations Package

Designed to provide education on the basic physics and instrumentation of ultrasound when applied in a POCUS clinical evaluation, making it the perfect credential for practitioners who desire to advance their everyday use of POCUS technology with their patients.

POCUS General Medicine Certificate

This program is an online certification program designed to provide independent validation of clinical providers' proficiency in eight (8) specialty clinical areas. Applicants will have 180 days to complete the program. Each specialty clinical area of this POCUS Certification is comprised of three components: a Clinical Case-Based Assessment, a Peer Evaluation, and Video Submissions.

- The clinical certificates were developed using a standard template that has been customized for each specialty. The clinical case-based assessments are designed to simulate a clinical encounter. Question types range from multiple choice to hotspots.
- The peer evaluation is designed to assess your practical abilities in POCUS. Clinicians of your choosing will be sent an anonymous questionnaire to evaluate your POCUS abilities. Assessment results are based on the first two evaluations received.
- The video submission is designed to assess your practical abilities in POCUS. You will submit two videos per clinical area: one without pathology, and one with identified pathology. All videos must be HIPAA compliant, .mp4 formatted, and 5-60 seconds long.

POCUS FocusClass from 123sonography

The Point of Care Ultrasound FocusClass is an online, clinical training course tailored for primary and point of care physicians, developed by 123sonography. The individual lectures contain a general introduction to the topics, image acquisition theory and demonstration, in addition to normal findings and pathology presented in real cases. The training is comprised of nine (9)

online lecture videos to help users enhance skills and confidence with using ultrasound in the clinical practice specialty areas of: Heart, Lung, Obstetrics, Kidney, Urinary Tract, Biliary Tract, Abdominal Aorta, MSK, and DVT. Pricing includes single user access, within sixteen (16) months from purchase date, to the POCUS FocusClass modules.

Review Course from Gulfcoast Ultrasound Institute

POCUS Emergency Medicine Certificate

Applicants will have 180 days to complete the program.
